Homework Challenge – Spring 2 2018

This half term we will continue to set a homework project based on our topic. We would like children to select at least one of the challenges below, however children can do as many as they wish. This will continue to be run alongside the regular reading, spellings and maths that are set each week for children in Years 1 and 2.

Our topic this term is '**Town Mouse Country Mouse**' and the following are all ideas that tie in with the topic:

<p>Create a 3D habitat in a shoebox. It can be any habitat: underwater, desert, rainforest, pond, underground, African bush etc.</p> 	<p>Pretend that you are the Town Mouse or the Country Mouse. Write a letter to the other mouse telling them about your new setting. Remember to use your 5 senses to help describe the setting.</p> 	<p>Find out about what it is like to grow up in a tiny village as a child and what it is like to grow up in a huge city. Which do you think you would rather do?</p> 
<p>Make a leaflet about how to look after a pet.</p> 	<p>Design and make a vehicle that can travel down a slope.</p> 	<p>Do a traffic survey on your road. Record as a tally chart the number of cars, bikes, buses, trains and vans that drive past your house in a set time (eg, 30 mins).</p> 

The challenge work is due in **Monday 26th March 2018** and on **Wednesday 28th March 2018 at 9:15am** each child will get to present their work and for it to be celebrated. Parents are invited to this session too!

The children will have their 'Homework Challenge book'. We are expecting **one double page** to be used for each topic or you may choose to make a model, depending on the options available.
