<u>Class 1</u> <u>Homework Challenge – Autumn Term 1 2017</u>

This year we will continue to set a homework project each half-term as we have seen some fantastic efforts from children, celebrated at the end of every half term with parents and carers. We would like children to select at least one of the challenges below, however children can do as many as they wish. This will continue to be run alongside the regular reading, spellings and maths that are set each week for children in Year 1 and 2.

Examples of children's homework can be found on the website under the 'Gallery' section.

Our topic this term is 'What do I need to be me?' and the following are all ideas that tie in with the topic:

Create a model of your family home. Show how many rooms you have and the different features in each room. Who lives in your home with you? Do you live in a house? Do you live in a bungalow?	Create a detailed fact file about yourself! What's your favourite food, animal, colour? How old are you? What are your hobbies and interests?	Keep a record of all the exercise or physical activity you do over a week. Write down the activity and how long you did it for. Work out how many hours in total you have done. Which is your favourite activity?
Find out all about your family by creating a family tree. How far back can you go?	Find a recipe for a healthy meal- it could be a starter, main course or a desert (or all three!) You could: -create a recipe card -have a go at following the recipe (take some pictures or even video yourself)	Create a piece of work that helps others to learn all about the human body. You can present your work as images with labels or create a model.

The challenge work is due in **Monday 16th October 2017** and on **Thursday 19th October 2017 at 9.15am** each child will get to present their work and for it to be celebrated. Parents are invited to this session too!

As we did last year, the children will have their 'Homework Challenge book'. We are expecting **one double page** to be used for each topic or you may choose to make a model, depending on the options available.

It is completely up to the children to decide how they want to record it. They could use photos, diagrams, drawings or something else! If you would like to do more than a double page then this is absolutely fine too.
