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




### Homework Challenge – Spring 1 2018

This half term we will continue to set a homework project based on our topic. We would like children to select at least one of the challenges below, however children can do as many as they wish. This will continue to be run alongside the regular reading, spellings and maths that are set each week for children in Years 1 and 2.

Our topic this term is 'The Potting Shed...Buried Treasure' and the following are all ideas that tie in with the topic:

<p>Make a 3D model of a plant. Can you name it?</p> 	<p>Plant a seed and keep a diary of its growth. What does a plant need to grow?</p> 	<p>Create an observational drawing of a plant. Can you label it?</p> 
<p>Go on a plant hunt outside and take photographs of the plants you find. Can you name any of them?</p> 	<p>Find out about George Forrest. What is he famous for?</p> 	<p>Measure some plants that you find outside. Record: Which plant is the tallest? Which plant is the shortest? Which plant is the widest? Which plant is the thinnest?</p> 

The challenge work is due in by **Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> February 2018** and on **Friday 9<sup>th</sup> February at 9:15am** each child will get to present their work and for it to be celebrated. Parents are invited to this session too!

The children will have their 'Homework Challenge book'. We are expecting **one double page** to be used for each topic or you may choose to make a model, depending on the options available.
