### Year 1: Spring Term 1

In English lessons, the children will be learning how to write a warning story and an information text. We will be looking at the books ' <i>Peter and</i> <i>the Wolf</i> ' by SS Prokofiev and Ian Beck, ' <i>Dear Daddy</i> ' by Phillipe Dupasquier and ' <i>The</i> <i>Elephant and the Bad Baby</i> ' by Elfrida Vipont.	In Maths lessons, the children will be learning about addition and subtraction and place value to 50. We will also be learning how to count in 2's, 5's and 10's.	In Science lessons, children will be looking at seasons and weather. We will be investigating and recording changes in the season (from Winter to Spring) and recording weather and temperature over a period of time.	In Geography lessons, children will be studying the four main countries which make up the United Kingdom. We will be exploring the key features of each of these places and naming the capital cities.
