English

English will be taught through the use of talk for writing whereby the children learn a text, they learn the skills needed to produce a particular genre of writing and they study further texts.

At the end of the unit, they use everything they have learnt to produce their own piece of independent writing. We will complete our unit on Instruction texts, looking at Dragonology. We will then move onto look at Loosing and Finding Tales, using the text The Miraculous Journey of Edward Tulane.

Alongside this they will be working on their writing skills and reading comprehension.

We will complete a Comprehension exercise once a week.



Maths

Maths is taught through the use of the mastery approach where the focus is on problem solving and reasoning to show that they have mastered the area of maths.

Year 4 will focus on Length and Perimeter

Year 5 will focus on Multiplication and Division

Year 6 will focus on Fractions

Once a week they will complete a short arithmetic test. These tests will be used to inform teaching.
