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

We would like children to select at least one of the homework challenges below for this term, however children can do as many as they wish. This will continue to be run alongside the regular reading, and maths/English/phonics homework that are set each week.

<p>Art – Landscapes</p> <p>Make your own symmetrical design using whatever medium (crayons, paints, felt pens).</p> 	<p>Science – Cycles in Nature - Plants</p> <p>Create a poster showing all your knowledge about plants, you could include their life cycle, requirements for growth, seed dispersal, water transportation and pollination.</p> 	<p>Geography – Spatial Sense</p> <p>Year 2 Draw a map of the local area, include a key, compass and human/ physical features.</p> <p>Year 3 Compare and contrast 2 areas - look at the human and physical features, the similarities and the differences.</p>
<p>RE – Hinduism - Divali</p> <p>Make a storyboard showing the story of Rama and Sita.</p> 	<p>Computing – IT around us.</p> <p>Create a leaflet showing casing your learning about IT around us.</p> 	<p>English – Warning story.</p> <p>Create a warning story of your own. You can magpie ideas from the model text and the book Icarus. You could draw a story map and box up to help you.</p>
