Homework Challenges – Autumn Term 1 2024

We would like children to select at least one of the homework challenges below for this term, however children can do as many as they wish. This will continue to be run alongside the regular reading, common exception words and maths/English homework that are set each week.

Visual Arts – Colour, Shape and Texture.

Create a colour wheel using primary and secondary colours.

Create a colourful picture using only geometric shapes (the shapes we can name). Think carefully about the composition of the shapes before you start.

Science – Living things and their environment.

Create an information booklet about one the habitats we have learnt about: desert, meadow, rainforest or underground.

Think about which animals and plants live there and how they have adapted to survive in their habitat.

Geography – Spatial Sense (Year 2)

Create a map of your local area, including shops, roads, and landmarks. Don't forget a key!

Plan and go on a walk around the local area. You could take photos to show your route.

Spatial Sense (Year 3)

Design a treasure map with grid references- can an opponent find the buried treasure?

RE – What did Jesus teach us? (Being Kind)

Create a story map to retell a parable that Jesus told.

Write a poem about different ways to be kind.

PSHE – Being Me

Write a letter to one of your friends explaining our class learning charter and why it is important.

Draw a picture of yourself doing some of the things you are responsible for at home. E.g. tidying your bedroom, looking after your toys. Try to think of some sentences explaining your responsibilities.

English – Journey Tale

Plan your own journey tale, draw a story map to show the journey tale and what happens.
