They are also expected to practise their times tables and related division facts. Skills such as telling the time can also be practised at home.

Years 3 and 4: Autumn Term 2

English

In English lessons, the children will be continuing to learn how to write persuasively and to write a wishing tale. We will be looking at the stories 'The Pied Piper' by Michael Morpurgo, 'Midas' and 'The Fib' by George Layton.

Maths

In Maths lessons, the children will be looking at multiplication and division. We will be learning how to solve problems and reason.

Science

In Science lessons, the children will be learning about 'The Water Cycle'. They will learn about Evaporation, ground water, condensation and precipitation and cloud: cirrus, cumulus and stratus (water vapour, humidity).

Geography

In Geography lessons the children will be learning about 'The British Isles'. They will be learning about the countries that make up the British Isles and will use maps and atlases to locate different human and physical geographical features.

Art

In Art lessons, children will be learning about 'Still Life and Form'. They will learn how to create form with tone, draw a still life using cross-hatching, study artwork by Cezanne and draw a still life using colour.

Music

In Music lessons, the children's learning will be based around the song 'Let Your Spirit Fly' by Joanna Mangona. They will sing and play instruments and identify elements of music such as pulse, rhythm and pitch.

RE

In RE lessons with Mrs Mead, the children will be learning about the religious importance of Christmas and Journeys.

PSHE

In PSHE lessons, the children will be looking at the topic 'Celebrating Differences' which includes looking at different types of bullying.
