Homework Challenge – Autumn 2018

Over the past year we have continued to see fantastic work from the children in our celebration assembly at the end of every half term with parents and carers. This type of homework really does continue to motivate children and enhance their learning. I would like the children to select at least one or more of the challenges below and then be prepared at the end of half term to share with the rest of the school. This will continue to run alongside the regular reading, spellings and maths that are set.

Our topic this term is 'Who's the Mummy' and the following are all ideas that tie in with the topic:

<p>Create some Egyptian jewellery. This can be done using clay or beads that you have had in jewellery making sets. You can use card decorated with different coloured squared paper or painted pasta shapes</p> 	<p>Create some Mathematical equations using Egyptian numbers. Search the internet to find Egyptian calculations to solve.</p> 	<p>Find out about food eaten in Ancient Egypt. Create a poster or recipe cards about different foods the Ancient Egyptians ate.</p> 
<p>Listen to pieces of music relating to Egyptian themes. What kind of instruments did the ancient Egyptians play? Create a model of an Ancient Egyptian instrument.</p> 	<p>Write a fact file about a famous Egyptian person, eg. Cleopatra. Search the internet and find pictures and information that will keep the audience interested when you share it with others. You could even create a PowerPoint presentation.</p> 	<p>Find out about modern day Egypt. What changes have happened? Compare Ancient Egypt with modern Egypt. Look at different features, e.g Aswan Dam, Cairo, Tourism. Imagine you are living in Egypt and you are working as a tourist guide.</p> 

The challenge work is due in on **Monday 15th October 2018** and on **Wednesday 17th October 2018 at 9:15am** each child will get to present their work and for it to be celebrated. Parents are invited to this session too!

It is completely up to the children to decide how they want to record it. They could use photos, diagrams, drawings or something else! All we ask is that everyone has a go, so they all have something to share at the end of each term.
