

Homework Challenge – Autumn 2 2018

Over the past year we have continued to see fantastic work from the children, in our celebration assembly at the end of every half term with parents and carers. This type of homework really does continue to motivate children and enhance their learning. I would like the children to select at least one or more of the challenges below and then be prepared at the end of half term to share with the rest of the school. This will continue to run alongside the regular reading, spellings and maths that are set.

Our topic this term is 'World War 2' and the following are all ideas that tie in with the topic:

<p>Create a picture from our class read 'Goodnight Mr Tom.'. Use your imagination from the descriptions in the book, or ideas from the film when we begin to watch it.</p> 	<p>Listen to the songs from WW2 and maybe learn one to sing to the rest of the school, or research and write a biography of 'Dame Vera Lynn', the forces sweetheart who sang many famous songs.</p> 	<p>Find out about food that was available during the Second World War and how food was rationed. Maybe find a recipe that was used and create a dish.</p> 
<p>Find out about the technology that was being used from the tanks, planes and vehicles, to the radar and decoding systems that were available. How did these help to win the war for Britain?</p> 	<p>Research an artist that was painting at the time of WW2. See if you can create a picture using the style and techniques of the artist you have chosen.</p> 	<p>During the war many posters were produced by the government to encourage the war effort. Search the internet to see the kind of posters that were being produced. Can you design one of your own.</p> 

The challenge work is due in on **Wednesday 12th December 2018** and on **Friday 14th December 2018** at **9:15am** each child will get to present their work and for it to be celebrated. Parents are invited to this session too!

It is completely up to the children to decide how they want to record it. They could use photos, diagrams, drawings or something else! All we ask is that everyone has a go, so they all have something to share at the end of each term.
