Year 1: Spring Term 1

English

The writing genres we will be learning are information texts about seasons and the weather and a quest story. We will be looking at the story 'On the way Home' by Jill Murphy. Grammar this term will focus on questions, exclamations and using conjunctions to join sentences together e.g. and, or, but, so.



Maths

In Maths lessons, the children will be learning about measurement. Our focus will be mathematical language used such as longer, shorter, taller, longest, tallest and shortest. We will be measuring using non-standard units before moving on to metric units.



Knowledge Curriculum

In History this half term, we will be learning about the King's and Queens. We will explore key elements like 'Magna Carta', 'Oliver Cromwell' and 'Charles 1'.
