## English

English will be taught through the use of talk for writing whereby the children learn a text, they learn the skills needed to produce a particular genre of writing and they study further texts. At the end of the unit, they use everything they have learnt to produce their own piece of independent writing.

We are learning about 'Recount Texts'. Our model text is 'Charlotte's Web Diary Extract' and our High Quality Text is 'Floodland by Marcus Sedgwick. These texts will be used to support their writing as well as developing their reading and comprehension skills.

They will also learn spellings within class by using 'look, cover, write, check'. Alongside this they will be working on their writing skills and reading comprehension.

We will complete a Comprehension exercise once a week.



## Maths

Maths is taught through the use of the mastery approach where the focus is on problem solving and reasoning to show that they have mastered the area of maths.

The first unit for Year 4 and 5 is Decimals

The first unit for Year 6 is Statistics

Once a week they will complete a short arithmetic test. These tests will be used to inform teaching.

The children also complete 3 questions at the start of each day which cover a range of areas so that they receive regular practice of a range of areas of the mathematics curriculum.
