This half term we will continue to set a homework project based on our topic. We would like children to select at least one of the challenges below, however children can do as many as they wish. This will continue to be run alongside the regular reading, spellings and maths that are set each week for children in Years 1 and 2.

Our topic this half term is 'The Great Fire of London' and the following are all ideas that tie in with the topic:

<p>Find out how to bake bread. Write a list of ingredients and instructions on how to make it.</p> 	<p>Create a scene of the Great Fire of London. What colours are you going to use for the fire and the houses?</p> 	<p>Design your own information poster all about the Great Fire of London.</p> 
<p>Write some sentences warning people of the dangers of fire.</p> 	<p>Create a song about The Great Fire of London. You could use the same tune as 'London's burning' or 'London Bridge is falling down'.</p> 	<p>Make a 3D fire engine.</p> 

The challenge work is due in by **Wednesday 3rd April 2019** and on **Friday 5th April 2019 at 2:00pm** each child will get to present their work and for it to be celebrated. Parents are invited to this session too!

The children will have their 'Homework Challenge book'. We are expecting **one double page** to be used for each topic or you may choose to make a model, depending on the options available.
