

Homework Challenge – Summer Term 1 2019

This half term we will continue to set a homework project based on our topic. We would like children to select at least one of the challenges below, however children can do as many as they wish. This will continue to be run alongside the regular reading, spellings and maths that are set each week for children in Years 1 and 2.

Our topic this half term is '**Sowing and Growing**' and the following are all ideas that tie in with the topic:

<p>Plant something of your choice- Keep a plant/flower diary recording what you have planted and when. Keep note of how much water you give it and measure its height. Present your work in a booklet.</p> 	<p>Draw or paint a picture of a flower. You could decorate your picture using chalk, pencil crayons, felt tip pens or collage materials.</p> 	<p>Design and make your own healthy fruit smoothie. Write a list of the ingredients you have used.</p> 
<p>Go on a plant hunt around your garden or local park. Take photographs of the plants you see. Can you find out the names of some of the plants you find?</p> 	<p>Create a 3D model of your favourite plant/flower. Can you label the different parts?</p> 	<p>Use the internet or a non-fiction book to find out about Charles Darwin. Who was he? What was he famous for?</p> 

The challenge work is due in **Wednesday 22nd May 2019** and on **Friday 24th May at 2:15pm** each child will get to present their work and for it to be celebrated. Parents are invited to this session too!

The children will have their 'Homework Challenge book'. We are expecting **one double page** to be used for each topic or you may choose to make a model, depending on the options available.
