This will continue to be run alongside the regular reading, spellings and maths that are set each week on Learning with Parents.

English (EYFS and Year 1)

Write a recount about something exciting you have done in the half term. What did you do? Where do you go? Who did you go with?



Science- Year 1

Draw a picture of carnivores, herbivores and omnivores?
Write a sentence about each of your animals.



Maths- Year 1

Make a model out of 3D shapes. Take a photo of it and draw a picture. Can you name the shapes that you used? What are their features (3D shapes have faces (sides), edges and vertices (corners)). Write a list of what 3D shapes you used to make your model. Can you write a sentence about their features?

Art- Year 1

Look at the artwork of William Hogarth. Can you paint or draw a replica of one of his paintings of children?



RE (EYFS and Year 1)

Draw a picture and write a sentence to say what gift you would take to Baby Jesus and why.



EYFS Knowledge

Create a firework picture using chalk, paint or glitter. Why do we celebrate Bonfire Night?
