Year 1: Spring Term 2

English

In English lessons, the children will be continuing to learn how an information text and a cumulative story. We will be looking at the books, 'Dear Daddy' by Phillipe Dupasquier and 'The Elephant and the Bad Baby' by Elfrida Vipont.

Maths

In Maths lessons, the children will be continuing to learn to count, read and write numbers to 50. We will also been exploring the length, height and weight of everyday objects.

Science

In Science lessons, children will be looking at how to take care of the Earth. We will be looking ways to protect the Earth's natural resources and issues with logging, pollution and ways to recycle.

History

In History lessons, children will be studying past and present Prime Ministers. We will be looking at when Parliament was first introduced and what impact this had on our country.

Art

In Art lessons, children will be exploring architecture and sculpture. We will be learning how to be architects and designing our own buildings. We will be studying Degas' 'Little Dancer'.

Music
