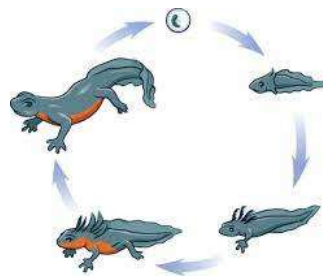
#### **Geography – British Geography**

Create your own detailed map – with a grid, showing the main places and attractions in East Anglia.



#### **Science – Lifecycles and reproduction**

Create your own poster showing the life cycle of any animal or plant you like. Top tip – Insects, birds and amphibians all have interesting lifecycles.



**History – (Y4 Life in Ancient Rome) Create an illustrated fact file on the volcanic eruption of Pompeii.**

(Year 5 and 6 The Industrial Revolution)  
Create a fact file on how steam engines developed over the Victorian age.



#### **RE – Stories in Sikhism**

Research a story from Sikhism (there are quite a few on BBC Teach) and draw your own comic strip retelling the story.



#### **Art – Chinese Art**

Have a go at creating some of your own Chinese calligraphy painting (you might want to wait until after lesson 1 of this unit).



#### **French –**

**Les vêtements (clothes) – Draw a fully clothed person and label the clothes they are wearing in French. Top tip – can you also include the colour they are wearing too?**
