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

## EYFS and KS1 Homework Challenge – Autumn Term 2 2018

This year we will continue to set a homework project based on our topic. We would like children to select at least one of the challenges below, however children can do as many as they wish. This will continue to be run alongside the regular reading, spellings and maths that are set each week for children in Years 1 and 2.

Our topic this half term is '**Blown Away**' and the following are all ideas that tie in with the topic:

<p>Create a poster about the four seasons.</p> 	<p>Take photographs of the clouds in the sky. Can you research the names of them?</p> 	<p>Make a rain gauge to find out how much rain has fallen in your garden. Put a plastic container or the bottom half of a plastic bottle outside. How much rain have you collected after a few days? How could you measure the amount of rain you have collected?</p> 
<p>Make a weather chart and record the weather for a week. Write the days of the week on the chart and each day draw a picture to show the weather for that day. How many different types of weather did you have?</p> 	<p>Make a kite to fly outside on a windy day.</p> 	<p>Go on a rainbow hunt in your home or on a walk. See if you can find something for each colour of the rainbow. When you have finished, try to draw your own rainbow using all the colours</p> 

The challenge work is due in **Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> December 2018** and on **Friday 14<sup>th</sup> December at 9:15am** each child will get to present their work and for it to be celebrated. Parents are invited to this session too!

The children will have their 'Homework Challenge book'. We are expecting **one double page** to be used for each topic or you may choose to make a model, depending on the options available.
