

Homework Challenges – Autumn Term 2 2023

We would like children to select at least one of the homework challenges below for this term, however children can do as many as they wish. This will continue to be run alongside the regular reading, and maths/English/phonics homework that are set each week.

<p>Art and DT</p> <p>Electrical circuits</p> <p>Can you make a game using electrical equipment where a buzzer buzzes or a bulb flashes when the circuit is complete?</p> 	<p>Science – Astronomy</p> <p>Create a model of our Solar System. This can be a 3d model, an orrery or a poster. If you make or draw the planets, can you get them to scale?</p> 	<p>History – The Tudors (Y4) or The abolition of slavery (Y56)</p> <p>Y4 – Make a factfile on Henry VIII finding out as many strange and unusual facts about him as possible.</p> <p>Y56 – Create a time line of how the slave trade grew and how it finally came to an end. Aim for about 8 key dates and events.</p>
<p>RE – Christianity - Christmas</p> <p>Make your own Christmas card (being nice and arty too) and choose to design it using either traditional or non-traditional Christmas symbols.</p> 	<p>Geography – Mountains</p> <p>Choose to make a model of a mountain or a relief map of the UK. A relief map shows the height of the land.</p> 	<p>PE – The handstand challenge!</p> <p>Get permission from your parents – who might just want to check you're in a safe place – can you hold a handstand for 10 seconds? It'll probably take a bit of practice. Take a photo of you completing the challenge.</p> 

We do ask that everyone has a go at this homework challenge, so that all the children have something to share at the end of each term. Please bring your homework challenge work into school on the morning of **Thursday 14th December**. All parents and children are invited to the Homework Challenge Drop In after school on the **14th December at 3.15pm** so that you can see what your friends have produced!
