

Homework Challenge - Summer 1, 2024

We would like children to select at least one of the homework challenges below for this term, however children can do as many as they wish. This will continue to be run alongside the regular reading (at least 3 times at a week at home please), maths/English homework that are set on Learning with Parents.

<p><u>Art - Freestanding structures - Year 1</u></p> <p>Can you use some recyclable materials and some cardboard tubes to create a freestanding tower? How are you going to fix your materials together? How tall can you get your structure to be before it collapses?</p> 	<p><u>Math's- Fractions - Year 1</u></p> <p>Find fractions of items/objects around your home e.g., cake, pizza, oranges etc. Can you find $\frac{1}{2}$? $\frac{1}{4}$?</p> 	<p><u>Science- Plants - EYFS (Reception) and Year 1</u></p> <p>Grow a seed and keep a plant diary. Draw/write about how the plant changes each day. How tall/short is it? How many leaves does it have?</p> 
<p><u>Computing - Year 1</u></p> <p>Use the keyboard skills that you have been learning to write about yourself.</p> <p>Tell us who you are. How old you are. Tell us about your family. Tell us about what you do and don't like doing. Tell us about your pets. Tell us anything that you like doing.</p> <p>Can you remember how to use capital letters, _____</p>	<p><u>English- Instruction writing - EYFS (Reception) and Year 1</u></p> <p>Write a recipe to make bread with a set of instructions about how to make it. What equipment do you need? What ingredients do you need?</p> <p>Make and eat the bread!</p>	<p><u>Growing and Changing - EYES (Reception)</u></p> <p>Create a timeline of your growth from a baby until now. You could draw pictures or add real photographs. Remember to label the stages of growth e.g. baby, toddler, child.</p>
