

Carry out your own experiment to see what happens to the time it takes to fall if you make its wing's smaller.</p> 	<p>History – (Y4 The rise and fall of Ancient Rome).</p> <p>(Year 5 and 6 The Victorian age)</p> <p>Create a fact file on one of the topics below.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Julius CaesarThe Punic warsQueen VictoriaThe Work houseChild Labour
<p>RE – Easter</p> <p>Create your own comic strip of the events that led up to Jesus' crucifixion.</p> 	<p>Art – Printmaking</p> <p>Explore making your own prints at home. A great way to do this is building up a raised layer on cardboard and only painting the raised parts.</p> 	<p>French – Les Transports</p> <p>Create a poster labelling different modes of transport in French. Think about: car, boat, plane, bike, bus, walking, scooter.</p>
