Year 1: Autumn Term 2

English

In English lessons, the children will be learning how to write a recount and an information text. We will be looking at the stories 'Mr Gumpy's Outing' by John Burningham and 'Wolves' by Emily Gravett.

Maths

In Maths lessons, the children will be 2D and 3D shapes as well as place value to 20. We will be learning how to solve problems using practical resources and pictorial methods.

<u>Science</u>

In Science lessons, children will be looking at animals and their needs. We will be looking at the difference between wild and tame animals and how to look after a pet.

History

In History lessons, children will be studying kings, queens and leaders. We will be looking at the Magna Carta, Parliament and the Commonwealth.

Art

In Art lessons, children will be introduced to the topic of 'line'. We will be exploring different types of line and use these techniques to create our own line drawings.

Music

In Music lessons, we will be learning songs from different music genres and finding ways to find the pulse, beat and rhythm of a song.
