<p>Life skills – Your challenge is to learn how to tie your laces and if you can do that, earn how to tie a tie.</p> <p>I'd love to see you upload a video to class dojo showing you doing both.</p> 	<p>Geography – Eastern Europe</p> <p>Choose a country in Eastern Europe and produce your own project on it.
