Years 3 and 4: Autumn Term 1

In English lessons, the children will be learning how to write a warning story and to write persuasively. We will be looking at the stories 'Icarus' which is retold by Susan Gates and 'The Pied Piper' by Michael Morpurgo.	In Maths lessons, the children will be looking at number and place value and addition and subtraction. We will be learning how to solve problems and reason.	In Science lessons, children will be learning about 'Cycles in Nature' They will learn about the life cycles of plants, amphibians and butterflies and will learn about seasons and migration.
