Write a diary entry about life in the trenches.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Science - Chemistry</u></p> <p>Create a 3D model of an atom Find out about the life of a famous scientist and create a fact file or write a biography or autobiography about their life.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Geography</u></p> <p>Design a persuasive leaflet to encourage people to visit either the Arctic or Antarctic Circles. Create a drawing or painting of the landscape in Arctic or Antarctic Circles.</p>

Write a set of e-safety rules that could be shared with all children in the school.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>RE - Hinduism</u></p> <p>Create a comic strip or write a newspaper article for a story of Hinduism.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>PSHE - Being me</u></p> <p>Write an autobiography about your life so far. Draw a self portrait or create a piece of 3D art to represent yourself. Make sure you can talk about it.</p>
