It was lovely to see so many parents and carers during our **parents evening** last Thursday, if you were unable to attend but would like to speak with your child's teacher please let the **office** know.

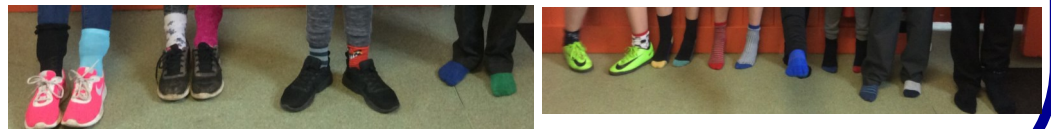
