<p>Art/DT – African Art</p> <p>Research different types of African art. Choose one piece you're most interested in and draw and label it with interesting information.</p> <p>https://africa.si.edu/</p>	<p>Science – Human Body</p> <p>Choose 1-3 of the units and create a leaflet to help others understand the functions of the human body.</p> <p>https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/topics/z7x78xs</p>	<p>History – Y4 Late Stuarts. Y5/6 The Suffragettes</p> <p>Create a quiz about the topic Suffragettes or The Great Plague. This could be created as flashcards, A4 question sheet, PowerPoint etc. Don't forget to make an answer sheet too!</p> 
<p>RE – Christianity (Prayer and Worship)</p> <p>Visit a church and look at what is important for Christians. Have a look at the design of the church, the windows, bible etc. You could visit the church closest to where you live or Sandringham Church where the Royal Family attend.</p> 	<p>Geography – Trade</p> <p>Go on a supermarket hunt to find fairtrade products. Make a list of what you find. Where has each product come from? What makes them fairtrade? Why choose fairtrade?</p> 	<p>Latin – Olympics</p> <p>Find out about the modern and ancient olympics. What did Ancient Olympics look like? How has it changed?</p>
