Repeating patterns feature a lot in Islamic art. Can you create your own repeating pattern? You can download and copy a pattern if it helps.




Science – Classification of animals

Design your own traditional Christmas card that includes the idea of the incarnation (Jesus representing God on Earth).




Geography – North America
