#### **Art -Islamic art**

Repeating patterns feature a lot in Islamic art. Can you create your own repeating pattern? You can download and copy a pattern if it helps.



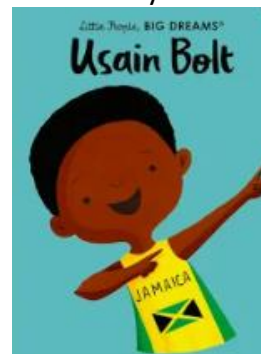
#### **Science – Classification of animals**
