Reading books will be changed once per week. Your child does need to bring their reading book into school every day so that we can hear then read when we have time. *Please note that your child will only receive a reading book once they are confidently able to blend sounds for reading*.

Homework

Please continue to support your child in completing one activity off Learning With Parents each week. If you have any issues, concerns or questions, please send us a message via Dojo.

Homework Challenge

There is a homework challenge for your child to complete each half term (Please see the homework challenge letter for more information). Your child will be able to choose which challenge they wish to do and bring it into school on the morning of **Wednesday 17**th **December**. All parents and children are to the Homework Challenge Drop In after school at 3.15pm. - so that you can see what the children have produced.

Library Books

Library books will be changed on Friday each week. Well done to the children who remember to ring their books back every week.

PE - Tuesday

All our children will be going to Lynnsport for Gymnastics on a <u>Tuesday</u>. We also have PE this half term on a <u>Wednesday</u>. Please ensure that your child comes to school wearing their full PE kit, hair tied back, and earrings removed/taped over (they need to be able to do this independently) on both days.

Food and Drink

EYFS: Autumn Term 1

English

Children in Reception will continue to have daily phonics lessons every morning to build confidence in learning sounds for reading and writing. Children may also have 1-1 catch up sessions to support them in filling gaps in their phonics knowledge. Children will receive a word or reading book when they are ready.

We will be continuing to learn how to retell stories such as cumulative stories (stories with repetition e.g. The Three Little Pigs). We will be using props and actions to retell the story as well as learning how to write simple words, labels and captions. We will be focusing on children's letter formation this half term.



Maths

In Maths lessons, the children will be looking at sorting and comparing numbers as well as learning ways to find one more or one less than a number.

Children will be assessed regularly and activities will be planned each week to support their learning. They will be using practical objects such as cubes, compare bears, counters and Numicon.
