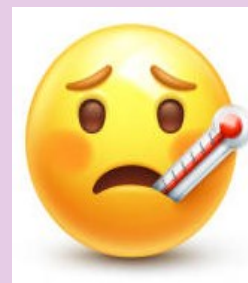
Could you please ensure your child comes to school suitably dressed for the elements.
