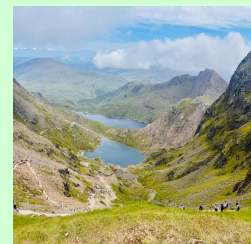


**Hello everyone,**

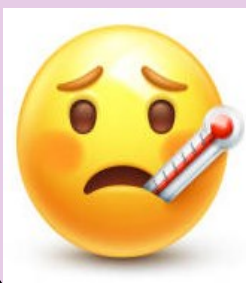

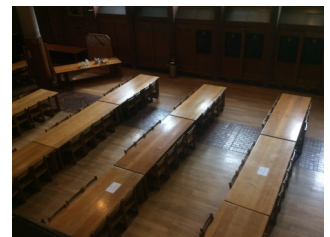
