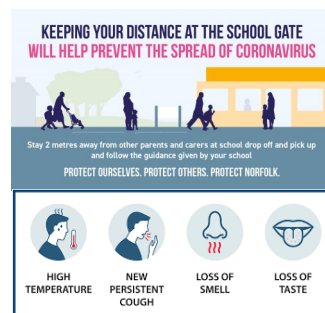
Weekly Newsletter - 21st May 2021
