

Walpole Cross Keys Primary School

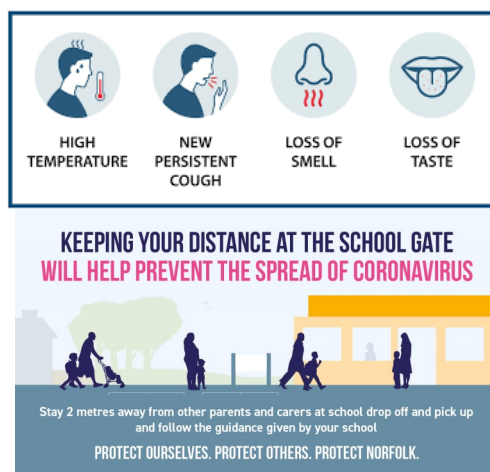
Weekly Newsletter - 25th June 2021

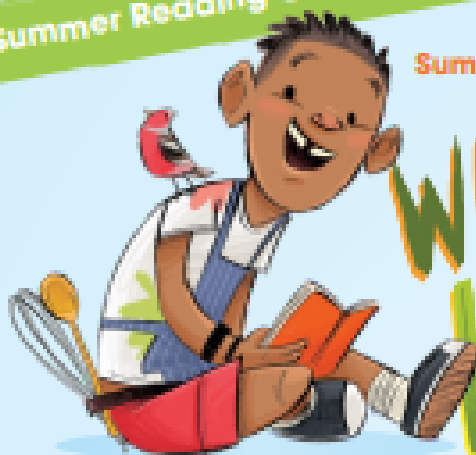
