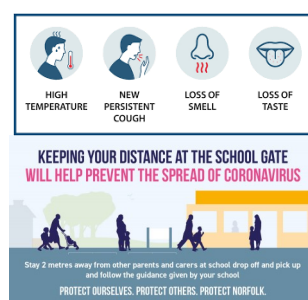


Year 6 parents/carers, keep your eyes peeled in Tuesday's edition of the **Eastern Daily Press** newspaper as you might spot some familiar faces.

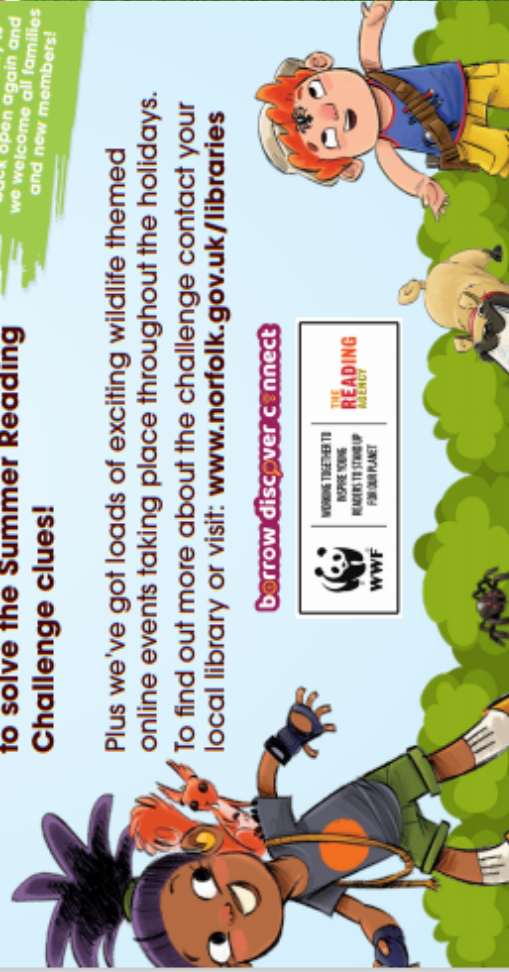
