Thank you to everyone who supported our Valentine's sweet raffle. We raised £33.50 and the winners were:

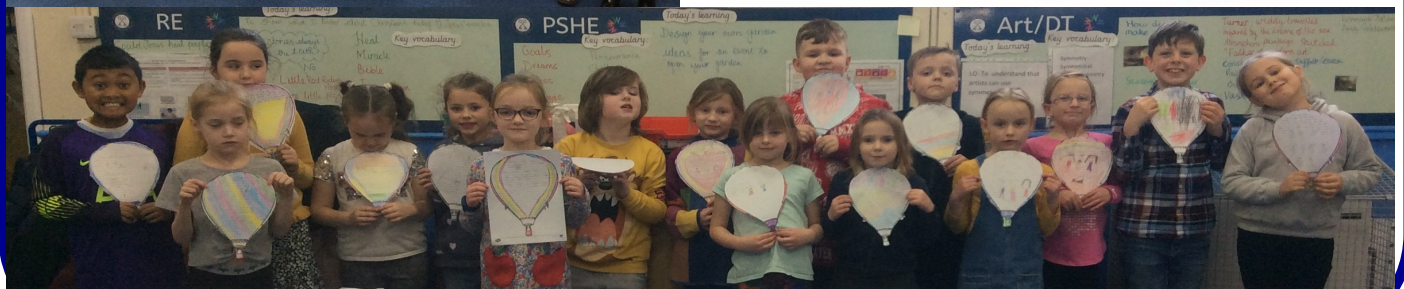

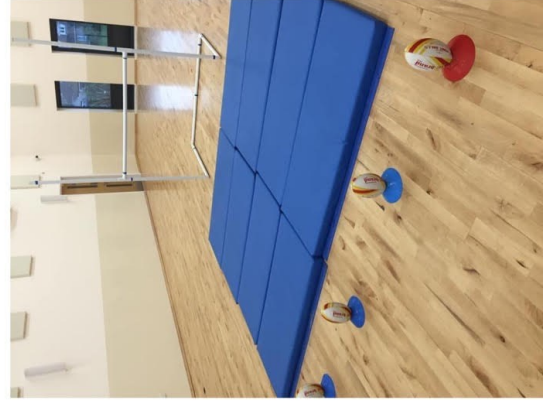
