

CREATE A SAFE PROFILE

Even though someone would need a child's phone number to add them as a centact. It's also worth altering a young person's prolite settings to restrict who can see their photo and stalus. The options are sveryone', my contacts' and 'nobody' – choosing one of the latter two ensures that, your child's profile is better protected.

LEAVE A GROUP

If your child is in a group chat that is making them feel uncomfortable, or has been added to a group that they don't want to be part of, fley son use WhatsAppe's group settings to leave. If someone exits a group, the admin can add fhem back in once. If they leave a second time, it is permanent.


Young people shouldn't engage with any message that looks suspictious or too goo to be true. When your child receives a message from an unknown number for the first time, they'll be given the option to report it as apam. If the sender claims to a friend or relative, call that person on the usual number to verify it really is them, o it's someone trying to trick your child.

CHECK THE FACTS

Vou can now last-check WhatsApp messages that have been torwarded at least five times, by double-tapping the magnifying glass icon to the right of the message. From there, your child con leanch Google search and decide to themselves whether the
