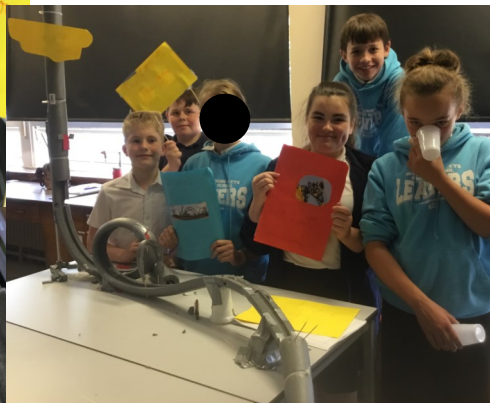
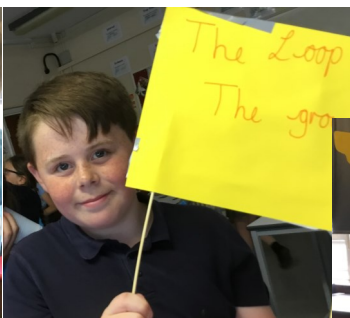
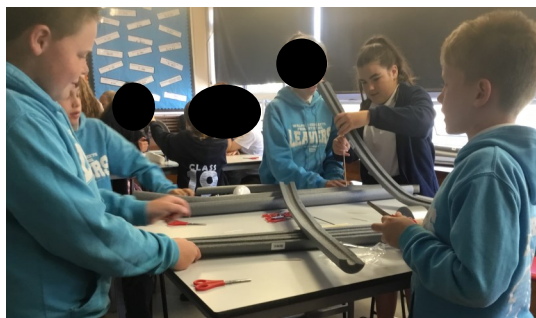
### Active Kids Festival—2/7/19
