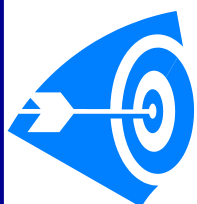
Some of our children in Years 3 to 6 have started music lessons, we hope they enjoy practising at home. Please remember to send instruments in with your child every Monday.
